GETTING AROUND

If you live in Somerville, we recommend leaving your car at home. Visitors arriving by car, please park your car and use the free SOS trolleys. Thanks to the support of the City of Somerville, resident-only parking restrictions are lifted during SOS hours. Parking on side streets is still limited.

- Never block hydrants or driveways
- Meters are in effect on Saturday
- Only use handicap spaces if you have an appropriate tag

FREE CITYWIDE TROLLEYS

Look for the Old Town trolleys which will run in **TWO** counterclockwise loops every 35-40 minutes, meeting at the Armory.

TROLLEY ROUTE

We have two loops that overlap at the Armory. The **West Loop** is marked in **blue**, and the **East Loop** is in **orange**. Start and end points are at the **Armory**. Trolley Tracking will continue to provide real-time updates on the location of the trolleys on each route to help you plan your journey.

TROLLEY STOPS

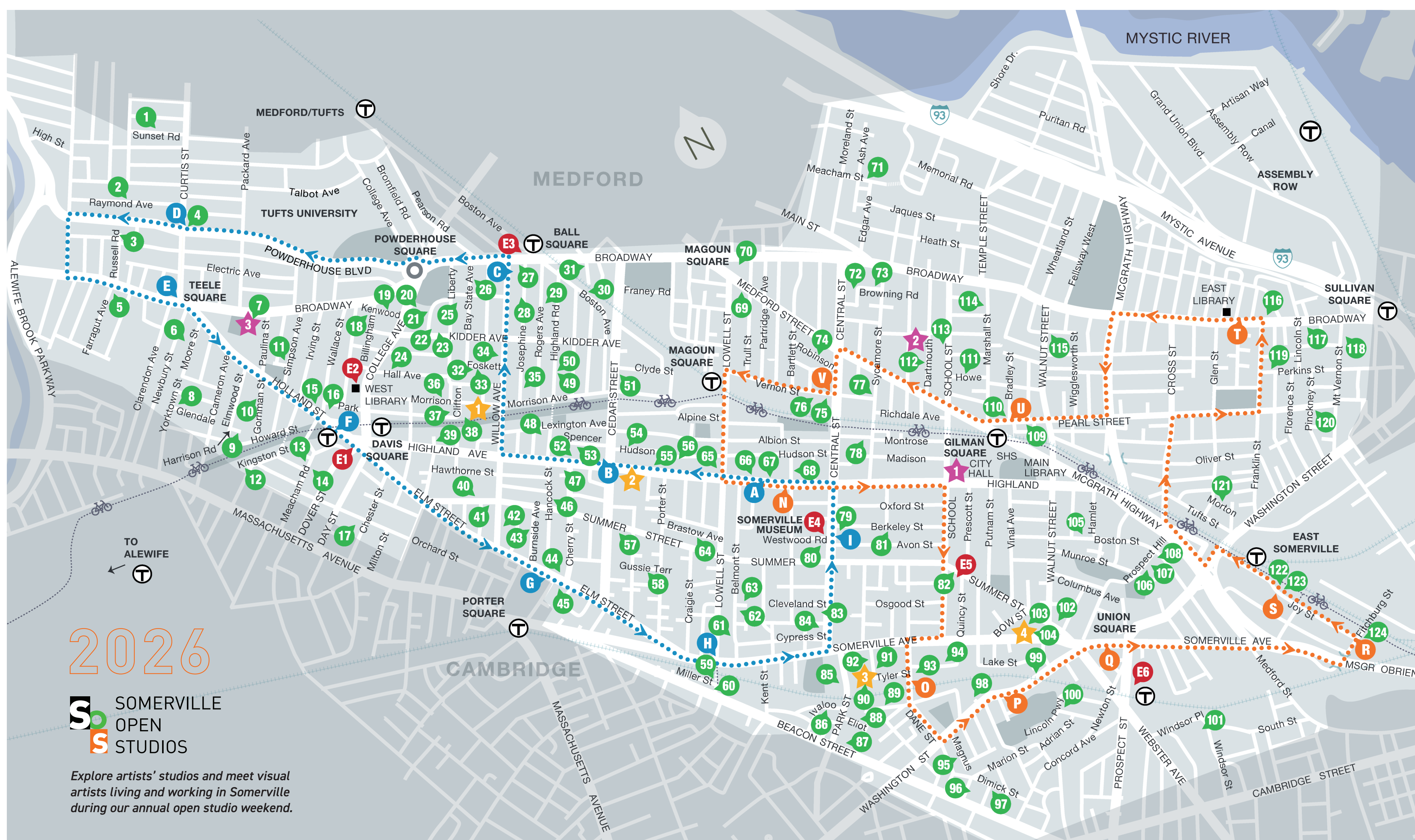

- I** Somerville Museum. Central St. @ Westwood Rd.

ROAD CLOSURES

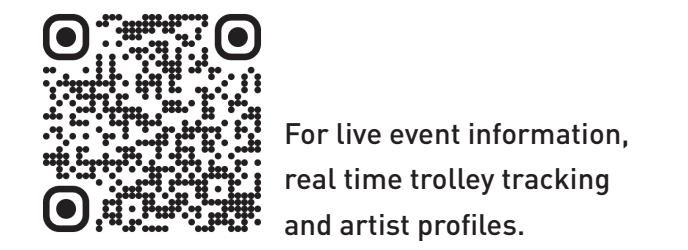

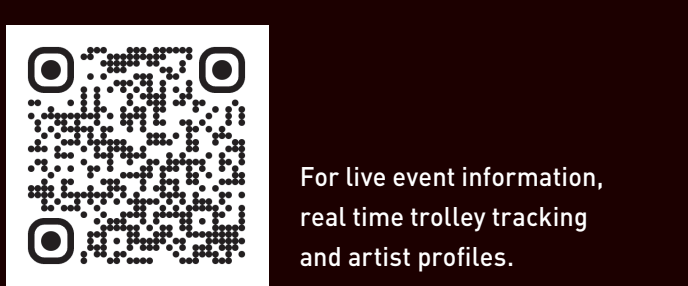
